TRACK SESSION ENTRY INFORMATION / REQUIREMENTS

- Remember all prices are for individual machine entries. You may enter as many machines as you wish using the session options overleaf. Please fill out a separate entry form for each machine which must all be returned together. (you may photocopy the form).
- Each individual road machine may be entered for a minimum of 1 and a maximum of 3 sessions (Saturday only) N.B. Except Cyclemotor/ Veteran/Early Vintage machines - 1 session only at special rate of £25.00. Veteran/Early Vintage machines must be manufactured before 31/12/1924 to qualify for the reduced entry fee.
- Each individual racing machine may be entered for a minimum of 2 and a maximum of 3 sessions (Sunday only) N.B. Except Race Sidecar - 2 sessions only
- Each individual session will have a maximum duration of 15 minutes
- You **DO NOT** require a competition licence to enter any of the track sessions. However you must possess a full motorcycle driving licence or an ACU or equivalent licence. You must bring your driving licence for proof of identity when you sign on at the event
- All track sessions are non competitive parades
- Road machines must be road silenced appropriate to their period, not exceeding 105db.
- Race machines manufactured between 1975-1985 with original exhaust configuration are not to exceed 115db. Machines manufactured after 1985 with original exhaust configuration must be silenced to 105db.
- Passengers are not allowed on solo machines taking part in track sessions
- Passengers will be allowed in sidecar outfits/3 wheelers taking part in track sessions and protective headgear must be worn
- There are NO road sidecar sessions available and ROAD track sessions are available on Saturday Only, with Sunday being reserved for RACE machines only
- All machines will be inspected for suitability and appropriate safety clothing, helmet and footwear must be worn, no jeans, no trainers. The organisers reserve the right to exclude machines or competitors failing inspection. (Guidance will be issued with the final instructions)
- Each ENTRANT will receive 2 All Area Access passes (except the Hailwood Suite) and appropriate vehicle pass to the WHOLE WEEKEND'S event (3 for 3 wheelers/outfits) irrespective of the number of machines entered.
- The track may be shut for short periods during each day to allow for movement of machines into and out of the paddock areas

INSURANCE

- The Liability Insurances, as arranged, provide for your protection in respect of Legal Liability regarding Damage to Third Party Property, or for Personal Injury to nonparticipants. The Insurances arranged do not provide for Accidental Damage to Participating Vehicles whilst taking part in the event, nor does it provide for any Personal Injury to Participants, irrespective of how caused. Should any Participant require Insurance Protection in respect of Personal Injury suffered during any Motorsport event they should contact their Insurance Broker or seek the assistance of a specialist provider of Personal Accident Insurance as they will need to make their own arrangements.

AGE LIMIT

- At the time of the event you must be over 18 years of age to take part in any of the track sessions

PAYMENT / CANCELLATIONS

- Make cheques payable to VMCC Ltd. or complete Debit/Credit card details on the entry form.
- Cancellations received before closing date for entries will be eligible for a refund subject to an administration fee of £10 - No refunds after closing date

ENTRY CONFIRMATION

- All entries received prior to 04/01/18 are guaranteed entry to the event (not including race sidecars).
- All entries received after 05/01/18 will receive confirmation of entry following the closing date of 01/04/18
- Please return your entry form immediately to avoid disappointment

FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

- All entrants will receive a Free programme with their final instructions.
- Regulations and final instructions will be sent out prior to the event

SPECTATORS / CAMPING /EXTRA TICKETS

- Weekend Spectator Camping available, pay at event, no need to pre book

EVENT OF FORCE MAJEURE (See declaration on page 4)

- An Event of Force Majeure means an act of God including but not limited to fire, flood, earthquake, windstorm or other natural disaster; act of any sovereign including but not limited to war, invasion, act of foreign enemies, hostilities (whether war be declared or not), civil war, rebellion, revolution, insurrection, military or usurped power or confiscation, nationalisation, requisition, destruction or damage to property by or under the order of any government or public or local authority or imposition of government sanction embargo or similar action; law, judgment, order, decree, embargo, blockade, labour dispute including but not limited to strike, lockout or boycott; interruption or failure of utility service including but not limited to electric power, gas, water or telephone service; failure of the transportation of any personnel equipment, machinery supply or material required for the event, breach of contract by any essential personnel; any other matter or cause beyond the control of The Vintage Motorcycle Club Limited.

Upon the occurrence of An Event of Force Majeure the Vintage Motorcycle Club Limited shall use reasonable endeavours to promptly notify you in writing of the reasons for the delay or stoppage (and if applicable the likely duration) and shall take all reasonable steps to overcome the delay or stoppage but shall not be bound to hold the event.

Upon delay, stoppage or cancellation of the event arising from An Event of Force Majeure the Vintage Motorcycle Club Limited shall not be liable to you for any loss, cost, claim, demand or penalty caused and for the avoidance of doubt shall not be liable to refund any fees already paid including but not limited to the application fee.
